Energy refurbishment of buildings is a priority



(1): Depending on the country.(2): Source: PRIMES. In billion EUR'10 / year.

- Buildings represent 40% of energy consumption and 36% of GHG emissions in the EU
- Only 0.4 1.2%⁽¹⁾ of the stock is renovated each year
- EUR 282 billion⁽²⁾ shall be invested <u>each year</u> in buildings refurbishment to reach 2030 EU targets
- EUR 214 billion/year in the housing sector only (EUR 87 billion additional compared to projected spending volumes)



PDA - Project Development Assistance

Call H2020-LC-SC3-EE-11-2018-2019-2020

- **Build** technical, economic and legal **expertise** needed for project development
- Remove legal, administrative and other market barriers
- Aggregate (pooling, bundling) projects to reach critical size
- Mobilize private finance
- All the main sectors (of urban planning) targeted

- Investments launched before end of the action!
- 1:15 leverage ratio
- Proposals from 1 single entity are eligible EU contribution 100%
- Budget 2019: EUR 6 million



Call H2020-LC-SC3-EE-17-2019



Financial support and services to municipalities (or groupings)

Via simplified "cascade funding" (max. lump sum: EUR 60,000)



Mobilisation of investments (incl. combination with EFSI, ESIF, PDA, investment platforms)

Develop solid and innovative investment concepts

- Potential project pipeline with critical investment scale (e.g. pooling projects and/or bundling with neighbouring constituencies)
- Financing strategy and process to launch investments, considering different financing routes
- Legal and governance analysis etc.

Deadline: 5 Feb. 2019



Innovative financing for energy efficiency investments

Call H2020-LC-SC3-EE-9-2018-2019

- Set-up new innovative, operational financing schemes
 - e.g. dedicated credit lines, guarantee facilities, on-bill or on-tax financing, etc.
- Replicate previously successful solutions
 - e.g. developed/implemented under various PDA facilities

- Establish regional/national aggregators able to develop large (standardized) project pipelines
- Create EU or regional/national energy efficiency investment roundtables/platforms



Integrated Home Renovation Services

Call H2020-LC-SC3-EE-2-2018-2019





- Create, expand or replicate "one-stop-shops"
- Single entry point to cover the whole "customer journey"
 - Incl. structuring and provision of finance
- Facilitate the access of local professionals to final customers through strong and trustworthy partnerships



Supporting public authorities to implement the Energy Union

Call H2020-LC-SC3-EE-16-2018-2019-2020

- Improved monitoring and verification of energy efficiency savings through enhanced coordination of different governance levels
- Development of transition roadmaps with clear path towards EU 2050 energy and climate targets
- Innovative ways to enable public engagement in the energy transition

- Large-scale and action-oriented peerto-peer learning programmes for cities/regions, which deliver public entrepreneurs able to drive the energy transition
- Assisting Member States to fulfil their obligations under the Energy Efficiency Directive, supporting its implementation with existing effective practices and experiences
